Restoration is needed for those who have been run down. (v. 1)

- It is done by those who are spiritual.
- It is done with a spirit of gentleness.
- It is done with the right motives.

Endurance is needed for those who have burdens. (vs. 2-5)

- It fulfills the "Law of Christ" (v. 2)
- It is not done in arrogance (v. 3)
- Check yourself before trying to help (v. 4-5)
